1.0 POLICY & PURPOSE

Funding coming to Laramie County Community College from sources other than established State appropriations or tuition and fees can provide much needed program resources, particularly for new projects and innovative ventures. LCCC strongly encourages new thinking on ways to support and advance the College's mission and goals.

It is the Policy of LCCC to comply with all regulations governing external funds.

Because the regulations governing external funds differ from LCCC's standard funding, the processes for seeking, securing and managing these funds can be complex and complicated. In accordance with LCCC's Responsibility of the CEO Policy 1.3.1 only the President or his/her designee may enter into legally-binding agreements on behalf

Organizational Representative (AOR). The Comptroller serves as LCCC's Certifying Fiscal Agent. Final signature authority for accepting sponsored awards to LCCC is the President or his/her designee.
