

- A. Academic standing is determined at the end of the fall and spring semesters. Academic standing is not calculated for the summer semester.
- B. Students will be placed on academic probation after the end of the first semester in which their cumulative grade point average (GPA) falls below a 2.0.

- 1) Students will be notified of their academic probation status by the Office of the Registrar.
- 2) A registration restriction indicating academic probation will be placed on the student's academic record.
- 3) Students on academic probation may register for classes for the following semester, but they are required to meet with a Student Advisor.
